<u>Job Title</u>: Greeter and Gift Shop Volunteer <u>Supervisor</u>:

Work Location: Slave Quarters

<u>Purpose of the Position</u>: To greet and welcome museum visitors and supply basic information about museum tours. Collect admission fees and sell items in the gift shop.

Responsibilities:

- 1. Welcome visitors
- Collect entrance fee using charge system, keep track of number and type of visitors.
- 3. Sell items from the gift shop and keep track of exact items sold.
- 4. Invite guests to view museum items, garden and to watch virtual tour.
- 5. Work with Museum guides in opening and closing the museum and coordinate visitors with tours.

Commitment Expected:

Shifts are on Saturday and Sunday from 12:30 – 4:30 during May, June, July, August, September and October. It is expected that a volunteer would work a complete shift at least 6 times a season.

Training:

Training on credit card charging system and reporting requirements will be provided by the Museum.

Volunteers are expected to be familiar with the basic history of the museum and the current programs (this can be found on the website and books) and be prepared to answer general questions about the RHSQ. Participating in guided tours prior to volunteering is recommended.

Attend periodic meetings with staff and volunteers to learn more and fine tune skills.
